Bio / Admin History: Alvin Warnke was born near Millet, Alberta, the youngest son of Herman Warnke and Bertha Grahn, German-speaking immigrants from Russia. He farmed on the family farm where he was born.

Scope / Content: The collection consists of pamphlets pertaining to agricultural practices, a program for the Wetaskiwin celebrations of Canada's Diamond Jubilee (1927), 3 post cards (1906) an advertising blotter, two blank farm account books, ration books from WWII, and one receipt. Warnke's baptismal and confirmation certificates (in German) are stored in Oversize Box #2.
