Bio/Admin History:	The Pigeon Valley Women's Institute was formed in 1942 in a district near Wetaskiwin. They were affiliated with the Alberta Women's Institutes, a largely rural movement dedicated to the improvement of domestic life and community. The women engaged in various fund raising activities and social events to benefit their community.
Custodial History:	The material was donated to the Millet and District Historical Society in 2002 as part the records among those of the Golden Glow WI found in the Helen Moonen estate.
Scope/Content:	The fonds consists of the membership roll, cash books, a guestbook for the 50 th anniversary and various clippings.
