In 1958 the division amalgamated with the Municipal district of Wetaskiwin No. 74 to form the County of Wetaskiwin No. 10. In 1996 the City of Wetaskiwin and County

of Wetaskiwin school systems were amalgamated to form

Wetaskiwin Regional School Division No. 11.
