Title: Thomas H. Howes fonds

Dates: 1945-[ca. 1978].

Phys. desc.: 2 cm of textual records. -- 2 maps. -- 6 floppy discs.

Bio / Admin History: Thomas H. Howes (ca. 1888-ca. 1978), from Holyoke, Massachusetts, emigrated to Millet, Alberta in 1900 with his parents. In 1912 he moved to West Virginia to study agriculture and establish a farm, but following his father's death in 1925, he returned to the family farm near Millet. He married Ruth Bloom in 1917, and they had three daughters, Esther (Soderstrom), Annis (Kerr), and Irma (Fleming). Thomas and Ruth were active in agricultural and community affairs.

Custodial History:

Scope /Content: The fonds includes minutes of a meeting called to improve a road in the Millet area; notes and essays on the Howes family and on the Hillside district; a manuscript map of the Hillside School District; and an annotated map of Alberta. Family genealogy printed for those who lived in the Millet area with a whole family genealogy on floppy disc.
