Bio / Admin History: John Smith and Elsie Augusta Smith married in Strathcona, Alberta in 1902, following John's military service in the Boer War. They homesteaded twenty-five miles west of Millet, Alberta, and were instrumental in developing community amenities in the district that they named Bonnie Glen. They had two children. Annie G. became a teacher in the Millet area and in 1916, married Robert Womacks. John A. Smith married Muriel Aikens and served as Secretary-Treasurer of the Village of Millet from 1952 until his death in 1975. He was also Millet's representative on the County of Wetaskiwin Schools Committee.

Muriel Aikens' sister Daisy (a.k.a. Sarah) married Harry Stuart (1924) and they had one son, Robert Stuart. They were two of the four daughters of Thomas and Annie (Maxwell) Aikens, originally from Ontario. They homesteaded in the Millet area. There were also two Aiken boys, Percy and Clarence.

One of the Womack daughters married the Rev. Young and one John A. Smith's daughters, Jeanie, married Mr. Zimmerman.

Custodial History: The donation of material on the Smith family to the Millet and District Museum and Archives by Muriel (Aikens) Smith and her daughter Jeanie Zimmerman was made in 2005. Helen and Colin Smith (children of J. & M. Smith) made another donation in 2006. Photographs were donated in 2004 by Jeanie Zimmerman and are stored with the Archives' photograph collection.

Scope / Content: The fonds includes letters, memorabilia (music books, cookbooks, programmes, school readers, and Royal tour souvenirs), essays, speeches, and news clippings concerning the Smiths', the Aikens' and Womack's family life and community activities. It also includes John A. Smith's receipt books, and his correspondence, collected minutes (1969-1973), and related records as a member of the County of Wetaskiwin Schools Committee. Photographs document the Smith family as well as the Aikens, Womack and Young families.
