Bio/Admin History:	The Millet and District Historical Society organized on November 30, 1976 and became a society on February 25, 1977. Its first project was a compilation and publication of a book on the history of Millet, Alberta, entitled Tales and Trails of Millet. Some of the photographs used in the book were donated to the Society by the original owners, and those formed the basis of the Society's collection. The Society continued to collect photographic documentation of the community and its families.
Curatorial History:	The collection was gathered together as the work of the Millet and District Historical Society developed. Images were collected from the community for exhibits, and such materials which were copied before the originals were returned as well as private donations given to the Society for the Museum and Archives make up the collection. The Centennial of Millet in 2003 provided another opportunity for donations to the Museum and Archives.
Scope / Content:	The collection consists of original photographs, photographic copy prints, and laser print copies of images documenting the community of Millet, its public life, and its families. The collection forms record group HS190 in the Millet & District Historical Society fonds A42.
