Bio/Admin History:	Sponsored by Millet businessmen and the Chamber of Commerce, the Millet News, later the Tellim News, began publishing under the editorship of Al Hegge in January 1971. It first appeared as a mimeographed 3-4 page letter-sized sheet dependent on advertisements from local businesses and containing some items of "news", mostly local events announcements and personal stories. The name was changed after a "name the paper contest" accepted "Tellim" (Millet backwards). It grew to 10-12 pages with the assistance of joint editor Dorothy Trathen. By 1980 Trathen was listed on the masthead as the sole editor, followed in 1984 by Lori Kjorlen. By September 1984 the paper was running a significant deficit and threatened to shut down. Instead it was taken over by Laurence and Valerie Alcock in April 1985, who upgraded it to a tabloid format, renamed it the Millet Tellim News and sold it for 35 cents an issue or by subscription of \$13.00. From its irregular publication it settled down to a biweekly format coming out every second Tuesday. Less than a year later Grace Balawik became the new editor and Linda Kidd managed the office. In October 1986 Balawik became the publisher/editor when she and her husband, Ken Hunter, purchased the paper in Jan 1987. Hunter's name first appeared on the masthead in March. When Hunter was killed in an industrial accident at a gold mine in the Yukon in June 1988 the paper was again up for sale. It was bought in August, 1988 by Sandra Fox who also became the publishing editor. In October 1989, the term "& County" was added to the title. The paper suspended publication in May 1991.
Custodial History:	Copies of the Millet News, the Tellim News, the Millet Tellim News and the Millet and County Tellim News were donated to the Millet and District Historical Society by Dorothy Trathen in 2000. Subsequent donations from the Millet Public Library and Jean and Gerry Scott provided issues to fill gaps in the original donation and duplicates for a reference copy of many of the papers.

Scope/ Content: The fonds consists of copies of the Tellim News, the Millet Tellim News, and the Millet and County Tellim News from 1971-1991. The fonds is divided into three Series based on the new owners and the changes in name.
