Bio/Admin History:	The United Grain Growers Company was a co-operative of grain producers mandated to market the grains nationally and internationally. Local producers joined in a local union to operate an elevator for the rating and storage of local produce. The local merged with Local 669 of Wetaskiwin in the mid 1990s.
Scope / Content:	The fonds consists of one minute book records in the annual meetings of local 261 (Millet). Later the local became #669 in the late 1970s. History of the local and photos of the destruction of Millet's elevators are included.
Custodial History:	The records were donated to the Millet and District Historical Society in ca. 2002 by George Jones of Wetaskiwin and brought to the Archives by Louise Reist.
