Bio / Admin History:	K. Kerr and Sons was an implement dealer whose store was on the main street of Millet, Alberta. They operated from at least 1942 to 1950. Besides selling implements and hardware they also performed repairs for clients. Kerr also owned property in and around Millet.
Custodial History:	The records were donated to the Millet and District Historical Society by the family in 1994 and 2003.
Scope / Content:	The fonds consists of a general ledger and receipts (removed from in between the ledger pages where they had been pinned) as well as correspondence relating to K. Kerr's activities in the community and business.
